

Classical Literacy Exam

Application Deadline: January 19, 2015 **Cost:** \$1 per student **Testing:** Feb. 9-13, 2015

Format: Students provide the term that answers the question. For study purposes, a complete list of terms and phrases is provided.

e.g. On what hill in ancient Athens did the Parthenon stand? **Answer:** Acropolis

Teachers determine the appropriate level of testing for each student, grade their own students' exams, and report results. Four levels of difficulty.

Medals for Gold, Silver, and Bronze are awarded on Levels I-III, ribbons awarded for the Introductory Level, and templates provided for sponsors to print their own certificates. Students may also choose to take the challenging *Classical Scholar's Exam* for which no official list is provided.
